



Children's Minister

Role: The Children's Minister has a heart that longs to see children come to know the love of Jesus and share that love with others as they grow into mature followers of Jesus. They will partner with our parents and volunteers to create a culture of evangelism and discipleship in our Children's ministry. The Children's Minister cooperates with the Generations Team to plan, develop, implement, and promote a consistent spiritual development pathway from birth to senior adulthood and supports the overall mission of SV.

Position: Full-time

Reports to: Generations Pastor

Oversight to: Children's Associate, Children's Ministry Lead Team, Children's Ministry Volunteer Team

Responsibilities:

1. Lead in developing and implementing a holistically focused ministry that helps children (K-5th grade) and families come to know the love of Jesus and share that love with others as they grow into mature followers of Jesus.
2. Lead in Identifying, equipping, and empowering a *Children's Ministry Leadership Team* of key committed and gifted volunteers to support the Children's Ministry. This team will provide input and leadership support to the following areas:
 - Sunday morning Children's ministry
 - Curriculum selection/development for all Children's programming
 - Specialized Ministries (Topical Studies, Special Needs)
 - Outreach events
 - Family events/programming
 - Summer Camp/VBS/Winshape
 - Volunteer recruitment, training, and coordination
 - Additional aspects as the ministry develops
3. Lead in identifying, equipping, and empowering a team of *volunteers* to do the work of the ministry of helping Children (K-5th grade) to be fully devoted followers of Jesus who Love God, Love People and Make Disciples.
4. Lead in developing a ministry to children and families of children with special needs.
5. Maintain materials, equipment, and supplies for the Children's Ministries.
6. Remain relevant regarding knowledge of effective ministry strategies.
7. Provide a safe and secure environment for Children and their families helping them to feel welcome and loved.
8. Prepare and administer an annual budget for the Children's Ministry.
9. Attend weekly all-staff, Generation Team, and regular one-on-one meetings with Generations Pastor.
10. Work in harmony with other staff.
11. Perform other duties as assigned.
